Each night, armed with red lights, we will set out on guided beach patrols to keep an eye out for nesting sea turtles and hatched nests. During the day, we might go on early morning walks to find hatched nests to excavate and inventory them; we might be involved in equipment and campsite cleaning, beach clean-ups to collect plastic waste and later sort it, and any other work. So, prepare for little sleep, sweaty hard work, and mesmerizing moments.

On our day off, we'll have **time to explore the other natural wonders of Costa Rica**. We may visit the nearby national park Corcovado, take a boat to look for dolphins, or take a day trip to Isla del Caño.

This trip offers not only an opportunity to **make a positive impact** but also a chance to **forge meaningful connections with like-minded individuals**. Working together towards a shared goal, you'll bond with your fellow volunteers, creating memories and friendships that will last a lifetime.

Whether you're a nature enthusiast, wildlife lover, or simply seeking an adventure, my sea turtle volunteering trip in Costa Rica is an experience that promises fulfilment, personal growth, and a chance to contribute to the conservation of these remarkable creatures.


